- III. Of the eleven courses, two must be in each of the following areas:
 - a. 512 (American History)
 - b. 510 (European History)
 - c. 508/506 (All 508 classes- African, Latin American, Asian, Native American History. Selected 506 courses from the Global list)
- IV. At least one course must cover the pre-modern era (i.e. the period before 1500 A.D.) See the pre-modern list.
