**Erica Moretti** is associate professor of Italian Studies at the Fashion Institute of Technology–SUNY. Her research, rooted in biopolitics, gender, and sexuality studies, and critical theory, focuses on pacifism, refugees and displacement, and humanitarianism in modern Italy. Moretti's first book, *The Best Weapon for Peace: Maria Montessori, Education, and Children's Rights* (University of Wisconsin Press, 2021), was awarded the prizes from the American Association for Italian Studies (AAIS) and the International Standing Committee for the History of Education (ISCHE). Her current book project is entitled *Across the Colonial Sea: Family Reunification, Vatican Humanitarianism, and the End of Empire (1940–1950)*.
